The North Car Park has at least 100 spaces for Blue Badge users. We have a dedicated queue for those with accessibility needs to gain entry. The Highland Hall is split over two floors:

My Gaming Life by Colin Harvey

I've been incredibly fortunate to have gaming as a constant companion throughout my life. Now in my mid-50s, I can look back and see how games have always been there, shaping my experiences and bringing joy.

As a child, my family had a caravan near Cockburnspath, where TV signals were scarce. We spent our time reading and playing games. Card games like Newmarket, Cribbage, and Gin Rummy were our staples, along with dice games like Yahtzee and Greed, and tile games like Scrabble and Tri-Ominoes, as well as Chess being a favourite.

My parents, being older, played their games and let me join in, teaching me the rules but never going easy on me. Even in Scrabble, I played with my own vocabulary, which helped me learn new words.

In my teens, I hung out with friends in their tenements, playing games like Game of Life and Cluedo on the concrete. Interestingly, we rarely played Monopoly, even back then people knew it could break friendships and families.

High school brought the British debut of Dungeons and

Dragons (D&D) with the Red and Cyan boxes. This game stayed with me through high school and into adulthood. Our group progressed from BECMI, to 1st edition, then 2nd Edition, but we didn't quite take to the 3rd edition.



By then, we were exploring other systems like GURPS and occasionally playing board games and card

games like Grass, Rogue Trooper, and Hero Quest when we were short of players.

We eventually drifted back to board games just in time for the hobby's explosion in popularity.

Over the past 25 years, I have gamed in person with friends once or twice a week, trying new games and revisiting ones we liked. We'd also organise gaming weekends away, where we'd hire a caravan for a long weekend and play games, logging maybe 30 plays over a weekend.

We also play online versions and rotate whose choice of games through a cycle, so that everyone gets to pick the games we play meaning we all get the chance to play our newer titles or go back to ones we particularly enjoy.

Today, I help run two clubs. One is at the school where I work, with 40-60 teens playing various RPGs for two hours, two days a week. The other is the Juniper Green Board Gamers, a club founded by my good friend Eric Ducreux. We believe games should be accessible to everyone and work to promote the joy that games bring to the world.

I'm always looking forward to spreading the joy and playing more games, tying it in with other hobbies like 3D printing to make custom parts and inserts for games, discovering new games, and of course, collecting the ones I love.

My Unexpected Journey Into Board Games By Craig Lockhart

Back in 2018, we invited my sister and sister-in-law over for dinner. They accepted, and mentioned they'd be bringing a board game.

At the time, my experience of board games was pretty limited: Monopoly, Scrabble, Guess Who... you know the type. So when they turned up with a brightly coloured box called "Azul: Summer Pavilion", I was both curious and clueless.

Within fifteen minutes, my wife and I were hooked. A few rounds in, and we were already falling victim to the dreaded analysis paralysis, desperately trying to maximise our scores without wasting tiles. I was struck by how much strategic depth was packed into such a simple design. That game night sparked something, and slowly but surely, the hobby took root in our lives.

We started with more gateway games, like Sagrada and Carcassonne, and loved them all. Fast forward seven years and our modest collection now sits at around 60 games, ranging from light fillers to three-hour brain-burners.

My personal favourite?
Lost Ruins of Arnak.
I tried to learn it online at first, but something wouldn't click. I was so drawn to the theme and the mechanics that I bought the game, hoping I'd work it out. Thankfully, it all fell into place, and is now my goto title.



We play every Friday night without fail. My sister, sister-in-law, a few friends, and our kids (who love Dobble,

Uno – No Mercy, Chess, and Coffee Rush) all gather for food, drinks, and gaming that often goes into the early hours. Over time, we've developed our own traditions and inside jokes, any time someone drops a game piece we slowly cry out, "Ohhhh nooooooo," (if you know you know) while everyone erupts in laughter. We now have more inside jokes than meeples.

I tend to be drawn to euros, deck builders, resource management, and worker placement games. I love watching new players have that "Aha!" moment. You can almost see their opinion change in real-time: from "This probably won't be fun," to "Wait... I think I love this." That journey mirrors my own, and it's incredibly rewarding to be a part of.

While we don't own many obscure titles, our shelves still manage to surprise guests. There's such a variety in modern board game mechanics that people often say, "I didn't know games like this existed." And truthfully, neither did I—until that dinner in 2018.

We discover most of our games through word of mouth or online recommendations. If a game's available to try digitally, that's a bonus, nothing beats getting a feel for it first. And if I could tell my past self anything? "You're going to need more Kallax."

The board game community has given us so much, laughter, connection, new friendships, and a hobby that continues to grow with us.

Around the table, everyone's welcome.

Everyone belongs.

And everyone's just one turn away from becoming a gamer for life.

Changing the Game on HIV and Sexual Health in Scotland

For over 30 years, Waverley Care has been at the heart of Scotland's response to HIV, hepatitis C, and sexual health. We are not just a charity - but a community. Grounded in compassion, advocacy, and lived experience, we work every day to challenge stigma, provide vital support, and ensure that no one faces these challenges alone.

We opened our doors in Edinburgh in 1991, during a time of fear and loss. People were dying of AIDS, and treatments simply didn't exist. Fear and stigma were widespread, and people faced their diagnosis in isolation. Now 35 years on, the landscape has changed dramatically - and Scotland is close to becoming one of the first countries in the world to end new HIV transmission by 2030.

Thanks to medical advancements, people with HIV today can live long, healthy lives. But stigma and misinformation still prevent too many from getting tested or seeking care. We understand the complex challenges faced by people living with HIV and other blood-borne viruses. That's why we listen to the experiences of the people we support to help guide our work - from shaping our services to influencing policies that reflect their needs and experiences.

We provide services to support people affected by HIV, hepatitis C and other blood-borne viruses

- Testing & Prevention: We provide free, confidential testing for HIV and other blood-borne viruses, guidance on prevention, including where to access PrEP, sexual health services and safer sex resources.
- One to One Support: We work directly with people who are living with or are risk of HIV and Hepatitis C, helping them to understand treatment options, and build their confidence and capacity to improve their lives in their way and on their terms.



- Peer Support: Trained volunteers bring their lived experience of HIV, offering a unique and powerful form of support to those who are newly diagnosed or have been living with HIV for many years, helping them navigate the emotional and practical challenges that can come with a HIV diagnosis.
- Outreach: We engage with communities at greater risk of HIV and hepatitis, to raise awareness and improve access to testing and care. Including free infant formula for new parents living with HIV.
- Influencing Policy: We use the experiences of the people we work with to influence national policy and help shape national conversations for services that are inclusive, fair, and accessible to all.

Our vision is for a Scotland where everyone living with or at risk of HIV, hepatitis C, and other blood-borne viruses is met with acceptance, support, and respectand can be connected to the right care, at the right time.

We're proud to be part of Tabletop Scotland's gaming convention, working together to create inclusive, stigma-free spaces where everyone feels welcome.

Where sessions have spaces available, you can book one hour prior to the session starting. So for games starting at 7pm, you can sign up from 6pm by visiting the D&D AL and RPG areas and add your name.

Our RPG **Games on Demand** offering also returns with a fantastic selection of games being run hourly. Simply go to the RPG desk on the First Floor to collect your boarding pass one hour prior to the session.

Note: Approximately 10 minutes prior to the session starting, our team will start the 'muster' in the appropriate area. This is where the GM for each game will be named, along with the game that they are running and the sign up sheet will be given to them. If you are playing in that game then you should go to that table. If you are more than 5 minutes late then your space may be given to another player.







All RPGs at Tabletop Scotland utilise the X-Card safety tool as a minimum standard. If anything makes anyone at the table uncomfortable, they either lift the card or simply tap it. They don't have to explain why. The GM will adjust the game accordingly.
